What is a "just transition"? It is the gradual movement to a clean energy economy in Canada. In this shift, worker well-being and Earth's ecological health must be prioritized, leaving no one behind.

Introduced in June 2023, the *Sustainable Jobs Act* is a pivotal step in transitioning from fossil fuels to a green economy. Currently under review by the Standing Committee on Natural Resources, advocacy groups are asking for vital amendments including:

- involving workers, communities, and Indigenous peoples in energy transition planning
- safeguarding the rights of laborers, including migrants and women
